



7. Sync it with your iPod or MP3 player

Plug in your audio device into a USB drive (using a mini USB cable).

Open the OverDrive Media Console from the icon on your desk top

From the Over Drive console click **Transfer**

Close any Windows or Mac windows that open, just click on the window that says: **Welcome to the OverDrive Console Transfer Wizard**

This wizard will guide you through the steps needed to transfer the selected title to a portable device

Click **Next**

Please select the parts you wish to transfer (you do not need to transfer the whole book at one time) you can deselect all and then select only a few chapters.

Click **Next**, it should download quickly and then click **Finish**.

Your audio book selection is now loaded on your device.

The OverDrive Console allows you to:

- Sort your titles
- Burn a CD
- Delete titles
- Download new titles from digitallibraryNJ.com
- Check due dates
- Keep track of your titles –due dates matter! The title will disappear from the OverDrive Console sometime that day (best to sync the title to your device the night before) titles will not disappear from your players.

My Account on the digitallibraryNJ.com website allows you to manage your account:

- Browse and Select titles
- View what you have checked out
- Place unavailable titles on hold
- View your hold list
- Edit of hold email addresses
- Display the titles on your wish list
- Find out when titles are available

Free Audio books!

DigitallibraryNJ.com is an application for Mac* and PC that syncs audio books to your iPod, MP3, laptop and PDA. Find best selling and classic titles.

This library is always open and everything is free!

***For Apple Products:** While many titles work on an iPod, only MP3 files will download to a Mac. At the time of this printing most audio books offered here are **not** MP3 files which means if you have a Mac there are not as many titles you can download.

Before you can start enjoying these free audio books, please take a moment to follow these steps:

1. Download and install the OverDrive Media Console to your desktop.

The console will help you organize what you have checked out, on hold or in your wish list. It is also the place to sync your devices with the titles you downloaded.

Start from the library website www.whippanong.org, click **databases**, and then click **Digital LibraryNJ icon**.

Once in the database, click this icon



from the digitallibrarynj.com website
Then follow the online instructions.

Once you have successfully loaded the Console to your desktop you can move on to the second step:

2. Log in and set up an account at the digitallibrarynj.com website

3. Before you download an audio book you will need to log in. Once again go to the library website www.whippanong.org, select databases then click on Digital LibraryNJ icon.

The digitallibrarynj.com website will open.
Click **Log In**

Under **Library**, click the pull down menu and select **MAIN, Inc.**

Under the **My Account** tab type your **library card and PIN number**

3. Explore the digitallibrarynj.com website and selection process (“shopping”)

There are links to help you navigate, answer your questions, and see if your



device is compatible.

Or you can start searching immediately by title; author or you can browse collections.

For every title there is information about the book and format:

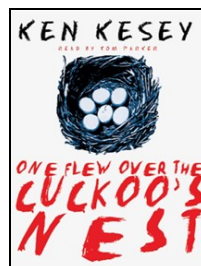


Photo of the book jacket

Helpful blurb

Red icons to make sure that the title is compatible to your devices.



4. Download Audiobook = Check out book

When you have finished “shopping” click **proceed to checkout**.

Click **confirm checkout**

You will see a copy of the book jacket. Click **Download** and follow instructions

The Overdrive Media Console will open and you will see your title there. Note the Due Date (your title will disappear from the console on that day). You just successfully checked out the book

5. Listening

From your Media Console you can listen to your book directly from your PC or Mac or:

6. Burn a CD

Place a blank recordable CD in Drive.

From the OverDrive Media Console click **Burn**.

The wizard will guide you though the steps.

Note: Not all titles are permitted to be burned. To check go to the Media Console click **Properties** and **License**.
