What Borrowers are Entitled to with the Museum Guest Pass

Hours – Tuesday - Thursday, 10:00AM – 4:30PM; Saturday – Sunday 10:00AM – 5:30PM.  
Closed Mondays, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Call for other holiday hours.

The pass is valid for up to 4 people to visit the museum at no charge, providing they bring the validated Imagine That Library Pass with them.

Morris Museum

Hours – Tuesday – Saturday 11AM – 5PM, Sunday 12PM – 5PM. Check website for holidays and special hours the second and third Thursdays of the month.

The pass is valid for General Admission for a family of up to two (2) adults and three (3) children aged 3-17 years. Children under 3 are free. Provides free access to any special programs that are included with General Admission or are free for members, including Tot Tours, Family Festivals, Super Science Saturdays, etc. Provides expedited entrance whenever the Membership Table is open.

Macculloch Hall Historical Museum

Hours – Wednesday, Thursday, Sunday 1PM – 4PM. Group tours by appointment Sunday – Friday.

The pass entitles you to: free admission for family members and up to four guests per visit; free admission for one to Member Programs; 10% discount as the Museum Shop; and a discount on Special Program Admission for family members. As with the Library's other museum passes it has to be reserved in advance, requires a \$40 deposit, has a three day loan period, and township residency is required for borrowing privileges.

The Macculloch Hall Historical Museum is a member of the North American Reciprocal Museum Association giving passholders free admission to over 1,000 arts, cultural and historical institutions, children's museums, and botanical gardens across the country, plus Bermuda, Canada, El Salvador, and Mexico.
